

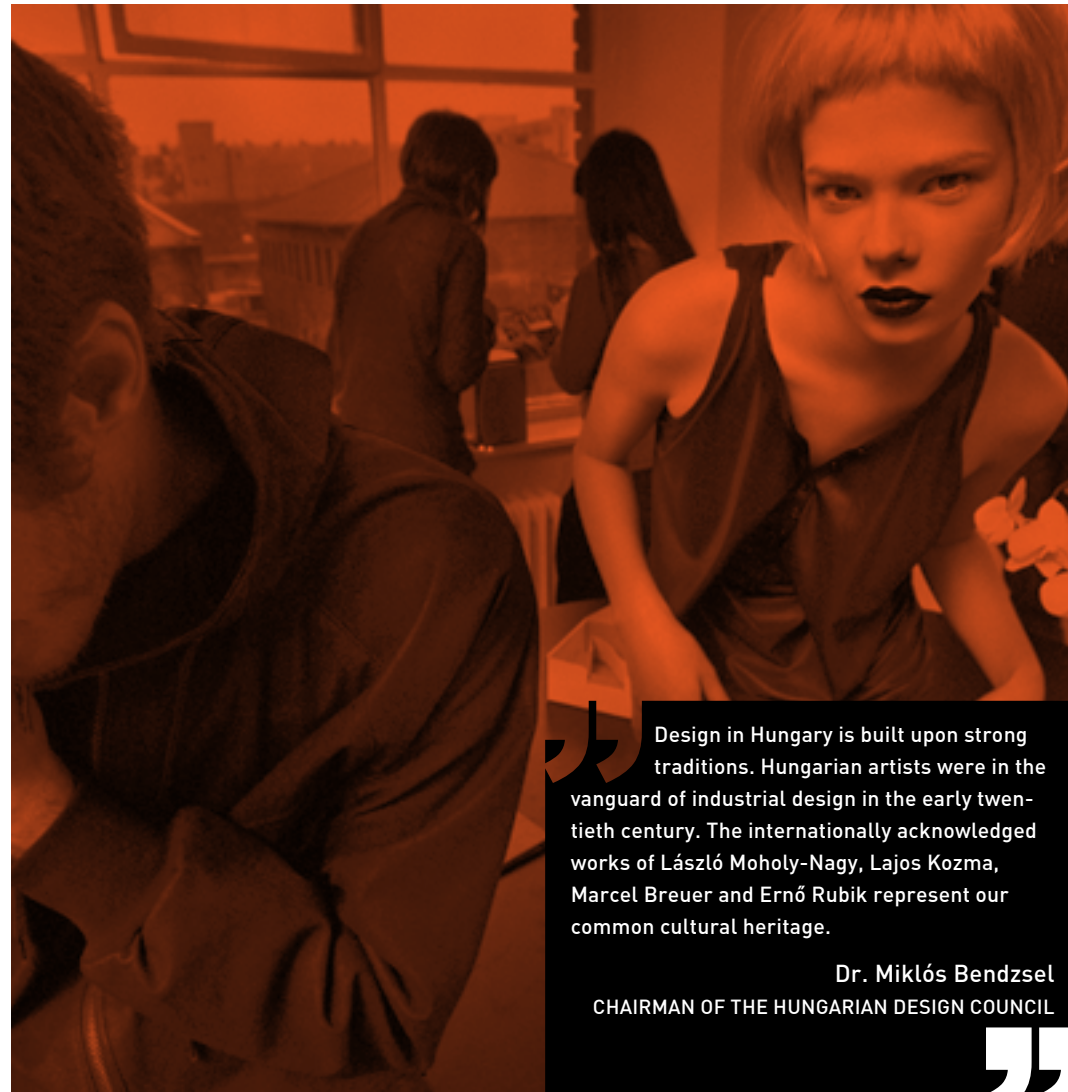
# HUNGARIAN DESIGN COUNCIL

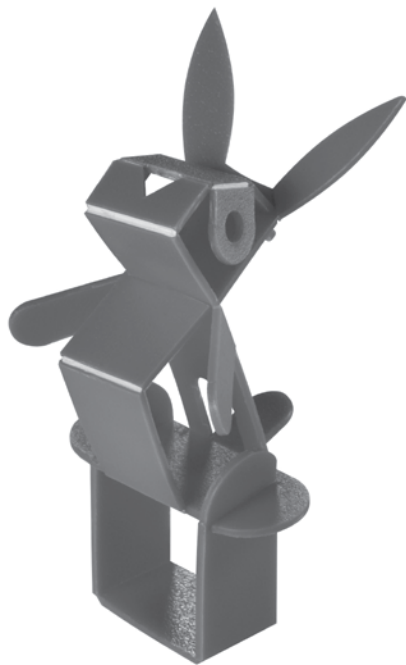
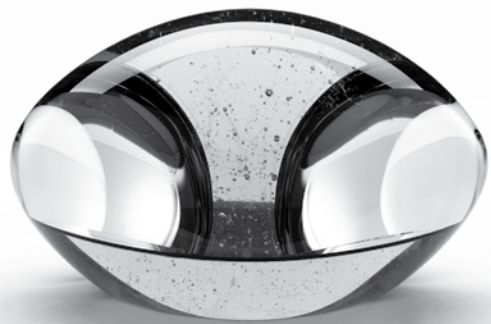

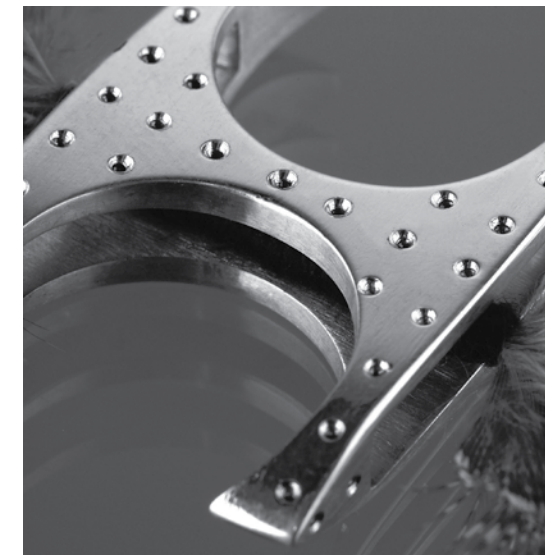
### MOHOLY-NAGY UNIVERSITY OF ART AND DESIGN BUDAPEST
