
- Traditional Due Diligence approach:

Initial (light) evaluation

- What is the technology behind the products?
- What IP is held?
- Are patents granted?
 - in what territories?
- Are inventors available to support future development?
- Other supporting IC
- Obvious show-stopper risks?

- Detailed analysis of competitor IP
- Assessment of potential partners
- Freedom to operate risk assessment and opinion
- Validity opinions
 - Investee IP
 - Key third-party IP
- Litigation evidence

IP development company

- Innovative company developing a strong and growing IP portfolio; preparing for a major fund-raising round and questions from potential investors.
- Patent portfolio critical to commercial success; important to understand its robustness in a challenging market.
- Client needed clear and formal patent attorney opinions under strict confidentiality:
 - quality of their patent portfolio ('Validity Opinion')
 - risks of infringing competitor patents ('Freedom-to-Operate')
- Both types of opinion require thorough searching of published patent documents to find related patents, along with a thorough technical and legal claims analysis.

IP development company

- Validity Opinion: client's portfolio was robust and welldifferentiated from pre-existing patents and other publications.
- Freedom-to-Operate Opinion: no unmanageable risks of infringement, although it revealed competitor patent applications requiring surveillance through the examination process.
- The combination provided strong evidence for investors of the robustness of the portfolio and an understanding of IP risks.
- The information also contributed to a thorough management review of the portfolio. It highlighted where additional patent filings were recommended to maintain and strengthen their edge over competitors.

Portfolio evaluation

- Market sector coverage
- Most patents are of limited value
- A portfolio may contain a few patents that dominate the value
- Can these be identified up front?

Indicators of value

- Citation analysis
- Clustering technology similarity
- Seminal patents
 - e.g. 'state of matter' or fundamental solutions to problems
- Timeliness
- Hi-value technology sectors
- Strong inventorship

Portfolio value realisation

- Selling patent (sub)portfolios to market entrants/minority players
- Managing risks of infringement in a crowded technology space
- IP collateral for cross-licensing
- Patent assertion/litigation
- Emergence of IP trading auctions and exchanges
- eBay!
